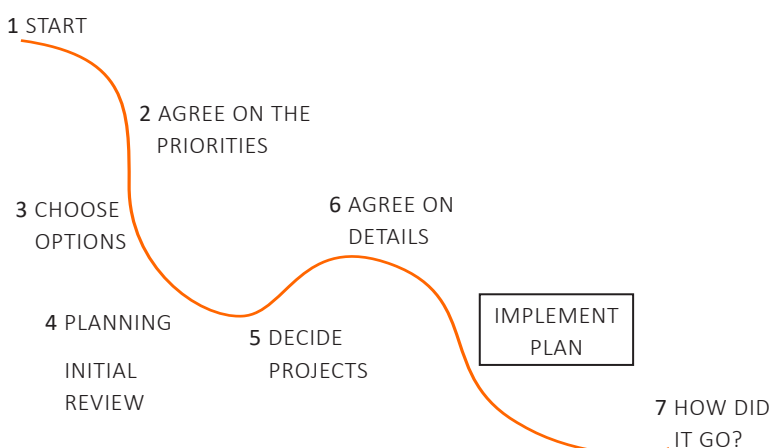


The new barbecue trailer in Atitjere.
