1.4 WILLOWRA LOCAL AUTHORITY ACTION REGISTER

Community Safety Patrol Rostering- The CEO noted that roster rotation is the responsibility of Central Desert Regional Council management. This is ongoing operational business. Item to be closed.

WYN Health Status- After talking to the Local Authority members present the Local Authority decided this action is no longer applicable because WYN Health is not operating in Willowra. Item to be closed.

The attending Northern Territory Government representative provided some information on the upcoming “Room to Breathe” program.

The representative explained that due to the high number of requests in Willowra that NTG would be implementing a “transition house” system.

The NTG representative asked the Local Authority about a few different houses, with one house (Lot No. 44) to be further investigated by NTG.

If the house is unusable the suggestion was made for a demountable house to be placed on council land.
